HCEC Winter/Spring 17-week session (January 15th - June 10th 2017)

High Country Equestrian Centre is located on the corner of Hwy # 8 and Hwy # 22. To get to the barn you go to the end of Hwy # 8 and through the traffic circles as if heading to Bragg Creek. You take the first left hand turn on Circle 5 Est. Rd and travel back towards Hwy # 8 for about 1km. Then you take a sharp right (south) turn and head up a steep hill and the barn is at the top.

Program Cost: 17-week session: \$1054.00 per rider (Plus GST) Total: \$1106.70

Program can be payable by post-dated cheque, monthly for the length of the session (5 payments of \$221.34)

Early registration: 5% discount if registered by December 15th, 2016.

The Winter/Spring session will run: January 15th - June 10th 2017

Availability is limited, lesson spaces will not be confirmed until completed registration and payment is received.

- ❖ All riders must wear a boot or shoe with a heel and **horse-back** riding helmets are mandatory. These may be purchased at various horse equipment stores in Calgary.
- ❖ Package must be paid in full at time of booking and is non-refundable and non-transferable. Cash or cheque made payable to High Country Equestrian Centre.
- ❖ All participants are required to have a Release of Liability Waiver signed prior to having contact with the horses.
- ❖ Students in all programs are expected to show up 30min prior to their lesson to catch and tack up their horse.
- ❖ If rider is unavailable to make their scheduled lesson for any reason, HCEC will **attempt** to accommodate an alternate time, within the week of that missed lesson. If the rider is unable to attend the alternate time within that week, HCEC will not reschedule missed lessons outside of that week. If High Country Equestrian Centre has to cancel a lesson for any reason, a make-up lesson will be offered in lieu.
- ❖ Lessons will be with two - four participants per program who are available at the same time and are of similar riding ability. Lessons will run for +/- 45 min
