- ❖ All riders must wear a boot or shoe with a heel and **horse-back** riding helmets are mandatory.
- ❖ **Payment options:**
 - Full payment made at time of registration \$781.20 or
 - Registration fee of \$195.3 and 3 instalment payments of \$195.3 payable September 1st, October 1st, and November 1st. Registration fee of \$195.3 is due on the day of the registration. If the registration is submitted the day session starts or later the registration fee and first payment must be made the same day.
- ❖ Registration is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- ❖ Payment made payable to High Country Equestrian Center.
- ❖ All participants and guests are required to have a Release of Liability Waiver and COVID-19 Liability Waiver signed prior to entering facility.
