DEWORMING

All horses will be dewormed the 15th of every month listed below unless otherwise indicated (time of year and product has been recommended by veterinarians).

MANDATORY DEWORMING – all horses are required to be dewormed the following dates using the products listed below. Shall veterinarians recommend additional deworming or a different product, the owner will be notified by High Country Equestrian Center staff prior to the date of the changes in the product and/or additional deworming (please check deworming wanted. If your horse is unable to have mandatory deworming, please accompany this sheet with a veterinary note):

April 15TH __ Panacur (Safeguard)

November 15TH __ Quest Plus

I hereby give permission to High Country Equestrian Centre staff to administer the dewormer checked above and realize they are not veterinarians and will not be held responsible for any reaction from administration.

YES. Deworm my horse (HCEC charges a fee comprised of the service fee listed in Board Rates for deworming plus the price of the product)

NO. Do not deworm my horse (I have attached a veterinary note with a medical reason as to why my horse cannot be dewormed)

NO. I will deworm my horse/ perform fecal testing myself and will submit the proof of administering the dewormer/ the fecal testing to the High Country Equestrian Center 3 days prior to the set mandatory deworming date.

I agree that all the information provided is correct and agree that if there are any changes to the information provided, I will immediately notify High Country Equestrian Center. If notification is not given in due time, High Country Equestrian Center will not be held responsible.

I understand and agree that shall I fail to deworm my horse and/ or submit the proof of the procedure, High Country Equestrian Center reserves a right to administer the mandatory deworming and charge set deworming fee.
